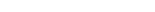
The American Ordo is a guide to the Mass and the Liturgy of the Hours for each day in the U.S. Liturgical Calendar.

On the weekdays in Lent, the Mass texts for the current liturgical day are used; but, with the exception of on Ash Wednesday and during Holy Week, the Collect may be taken from a Memorial which happens to be inscribed in the General Calendar for that day.

On the weekdays in Easter: the Mass texts for the current liturgical day or a Memorial for that day may be used. Masses for Various Needs and Occasions and Votive Masses are in principle forbidden, but may be used in real necessity or for pastoral advantage.
