The American Ordo is a guide to the Mass and the Liturgy of the Hours for each day in the U.S. Liturgical Calendar.

On weekdays in Ordinary Time with an Optional Memorial, one may choose the Mass of the weekday, or the Mass of the Optional Memorial or the Mass of any Saint inscribed in the Martyrology for that day, or a Mass for Various Needs and Occasions, or a Votive Mass.

On the weekdays in Lent, the Mass texts for the current liturgical day are used; but, with the exception of on Ash Wednesday and during Holy Week, the Collect may be taken from a Memorial which happens to be inscribed in the General Calendar for that day.

- The *Gloria* is omitted on Lenten Sundays.
- Unless indicated, Preface I-IV of Lent is used.
- Memorials occurring during Lent are omitted or observed as commemorations as follows:
 - Office of Readings add the hagiographical reading and its responsory to the readings and the responses of the Lenten proper; conclude with the prayer of the saint
 - Morning and Evening Prayer add the antiphon from the proper or common and the prayer of the saint after the prayer of the
 - At Mass the collect of the Saint may replace the collect of the Lenten day.
